This competition may not be restricted to invited riders or limited to less than 40 riders. Visiting members who are resident in this country may compete and will be eligible for points. To ensure consistency, competitors must use the correct tack, as listed in the FEI rule book. FEI anti doping regulations will apply. Table A9 two round competition. The best five scores, or all clear rounds, will go forward to the second round, which will be against the clock. In the event of equality, faults and time will decide i.e. the fastest four faulters will qualify. All scores in the first round will be carried forward to the second round. Competitors in the second round will start in reverse order of merit or the slowest four faulters will go first, the fastest clear last. If necessary, those who do not reach the second round, faults and time in the first round will determine their placings. If a competitor withdraws from the second round, he/she will receive the placing from the first round, however he/she will be placed after those who compete in the second round. All prizes will be awarded. Speed 400 mpm. First Round Height Fences 1-7 Verticals approx 1-50M and Parallels 1-45M approx. To include one triple combination in the first seven fences. Second Round minimum of 9 fences all raised in height and width from the first round. May include a raised combination. Total prize fund £7500

## **Qualifies for League Points and Bonus Rider Ranking Points**

The highest eight placed horse/rider combinations on the league table following the last qualifier at Royal Berkshire will receive bonus Rider Ranking Points to the value of:

**1<sup>st</sup> £10000 2<sup>nd</sup> £8000 3<sup>rd</sup> £7000 4<sup>th</sup> £6000 5<sup>th</sup> £5000 6<sup>th</sup> £4000 7<sup>th</sup> £3000 8<sup>th</sup> £2000**

Please Note: these are bonus rider ranking points and not cash awards .A points System will be awarded based on the following system.

**1<sup>st</sup> 12 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 8 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 7 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 6 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 5 points, 7<sup>th</sup> 4 points, 8<sup>th</sup> 3points**

Horse/Rider combinations placed equal will share equally the total point attributable to the combined placings (For example, four riders placed 4<sup>th</sup> equal receive 7+6+5+4 divided by 4=5.5points each)

A wild card to compete in the international classes at the 2014 Horse of the Year Show is available via a point's league encompassing both the International Stairway and International Trial competitions.

## Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors enter at their own risk. The Committee, Show Organisers, their Employees, Officials or Volunteers cannot be held responsible for any accident, injury, damage, theft or illness howsoever caused to horses, riders, owners, Spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any such incident.
2. The Show Organisers retain as their absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or return any entry Fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
3. All classes are run under the rules and regulations of British Show jumping.
4. All riders whilst mounted must wear hard hats to conform to the latest British Safety Standards as per British Showjumping rules.
5. Dogs are permitted in the Lorry Park and car park only. They must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. Any person failing to control their dog/s may be asked to leave the showground.
6. Warm up is restricted to specified areas only.
7. All exhibitors must be correctly dressed when walking the course and all exhibitors must attend any prize giving mounted. Failure to do so may result in prize money being withheld as per rule 76.6.1.
8. The show organisers and judges decisions are final.
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter and/or cancel classes with prior permission. From British Show jumping or to refuse entries without reason.
10. Entries will only be accepted with payment or open cheque.
11. British Show jumping Rule 82.20: No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
12. The expenses of any farrier or veterinary services rendered on the showground must be borne by the competitor or owner of the animal.
13. Entries for all classes, unless pre-entry, will close half an hour after the start of each class.
14. Any objections should be submitted to the secretary within 30 minutes immediately following the class along with a deposit of £100 which will be returnable if the objection is upheld.
